Hollywood A-lister and Pantene Beautiful Lengths ambassador Naomi Watts talks beauty secrets



You always look incredible – how do you do it?

I don't always look incredible [laughs]. I have professionals helping me. A lot of the time I walk out the door paying very little attention to my appearance as I'm rushing to take the kids to school. Obviously if it's an event where cameras will be involved, I'll work a bit harder. Sleep and water are the obvious ones – they're no secret. Then there is taking care of your hair. I've got a lot of it but it is very fine and can get quite lank if I'm not using the right product. I use the Pantene Aqua Light line that creates volume.

What make-up products take pride of place in your bathroom?

I get lots and lots of different types of make-up but I always go for cream blush. I'm very big on strong eyebrows and I tint my eyelashes. Framing the eyes is always a good trick. Jo Malone is nice for body and bath oils.
